RULES

You must have Local Union President's and Financial Secretary's signatures on back of entry form.

Bowlers must be members in good standing in a UAW Local Union or UAW Retiree Chapter in UAW Region 3 (Indiana and Kentucky), or a spouse of a UAW member. A bowler who has a UAW honorable withdrawal transfer card may participate in the Tournament, subject to approval by his or her Local Union. The Local Union President and Financial Secretary must verify eligibility on the back of this entry form.

This Regional Tourney is affiliated with the UAW International "Team Finals Championship." The affiliation fee of \$2.00 per team is taken from the total Regional team entry fees. Prize fees will be returned 100 percent in prize fund.

In case a team qualifies but does not wish to, or cannot participate in the UAW International Team Finals Championship, the tournament secretary may replace this team with the highest team that failed to qualify.

Averages

Entrants will use their highest USBC sanctioned league average based on a minimum of 21 games or more for the 2008-2009 season. If current 21 or more games average as of December 18, 2009 is 10 or more pins above the 2008-2009 average, current average must be used. If no average last year, use highest current USBC sanctioned average of 21 games or more as of December 18, 2009. All others will bowl scratch. **Summer Leagues averages will not be accepted.**

Incorrect Averages (USBC Rule 319a – 1, 2, 3 will be strictly adhered to)

It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average, whether originally submitted by the bowler, their team captain, or others. Failure to use the proper average or make a correction prior to completion of the first game of a series shall disqualify score if **submitted average is lower than actual average** or base prize winnings on **submitted average if it is higher.**

Bowlers are cautioned to familiarize themselves with the re-rating requirements of USBC Rule 319e and Rule 319a-1, 2, 3. Rule 319e will apply to all participants. Rule 319a automatically applies. Prize ratios will comply with USBC Rules 308c, 307d, and 309d. One prize for each ten entries.

Entry fee must accompany entry form.

A bowler can bowl **only once** in each event.

There will be four separate divisions, namely, men, women, mixed, and 55+. Each will have separate prize lists.

All bowlers must be 55 years old or over to bowl in the 55+ division.

Last minute substitutions made immediately prior to starting time of any event are irrevocable.

There must be two or more women for the mixed team event.

Preferred dates and times will be reserved on a first come, first served basis wherever possible. However, because of conditions over which we have no control, lanes, date, and time will be assigned by the Tournament Secretary.

Absolutely no changes in lineups.

The ALL EVENTS will be on ACTUAL score only. ALL EVENTS is optional (Rule 306).

Unaffiliated teams and individuals wishing to secure the high score protection may establish eligibility by paying unattached individual membership dues of USBC \$19.00 per entrant. Upon receipt of the dues, the Congress will issue an unattached individual membership card.

Rule 324a, in its entirety, will be in effect in this tournament. **Bowlers are requested to check in or make necessary changes one-half hour before starting time.**

Errors in scoring must be reported to the Tournament Committee within forty-eight (48) hours after the completion of the event in which the error occurred. The Tournament Committee disclaims ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR ERRORS UNLESS THIS RULE IS STRICTLY ADHERED TO. (USBC Rule 327b) Be certain to check your score promptly.

The right to refuse entries is reserved by the Committee.

IF ENTRIES SO DICTATE, ADDITIONAL DATES WILL BE ADDED. NOTIFICATION OF SUCH WILL BE MADE PRIOR TO THE START OF THE TOURNAMENT.
